

# 3+1 Articulation Agreement between Stockton University and Ocean County College

This Articulation Agreement ("Agreement") between Ocean County College ("OCC") and Stockton University ("Stockton"), in effect as of September 26, 2024, provides a distinct educational pathway between select associate degree programs and corresponding bachelor's degree programs. This document is titled a 3+1 program, is authorized by law, in accordance with the New Jersey State Constitution. This Agreement is between Ocean County College and Stockton University. Students, after completing their first associate degree, to enroll in a bachelor's degree program at Stockton University.

**Transfer Guidelines**

The intent of the 3+1 Pathway is to empower students to plan their full educational experience in a cost-effective way that will begin at the community college level and culminate in a baccalaureate degree from Stockton University. Ocean County College students who are admissible to Stockton may transfer credits designated under a 3+1 Pathway, subject to the following terms and conditions:

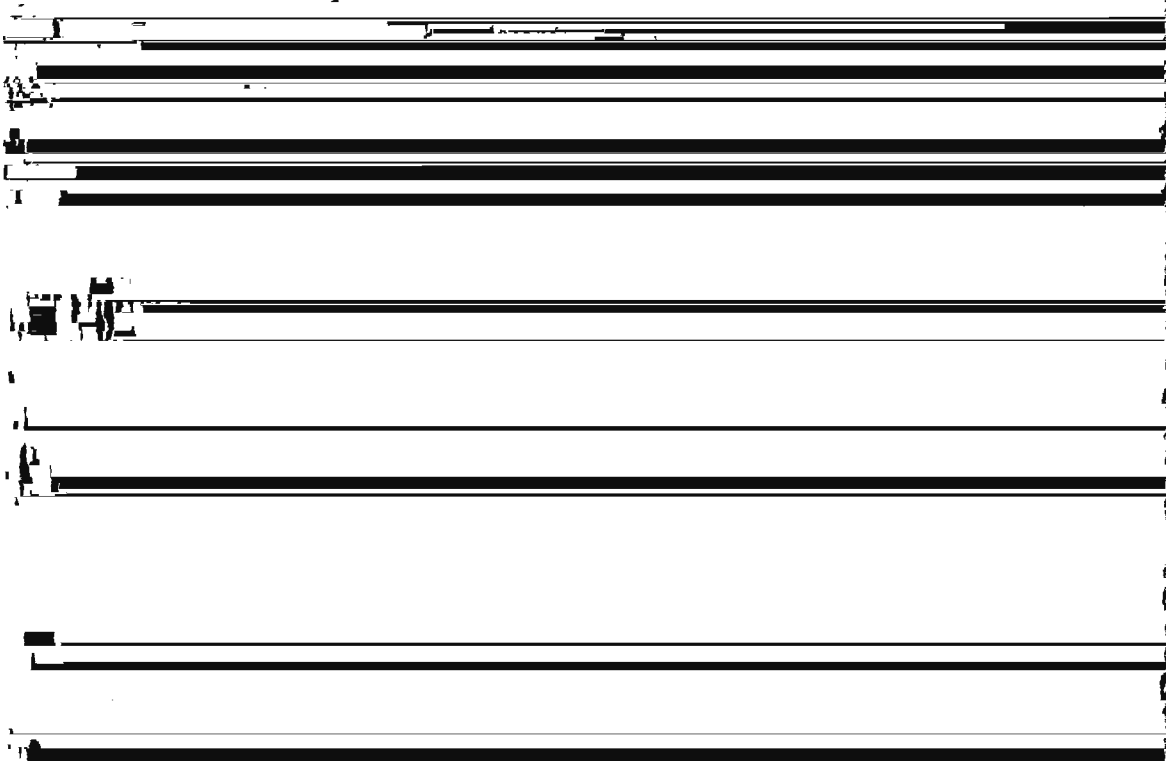
