
The intent of this agreement is to facilitate the smooth transfer and transition of students from the associate upper level programs


This agreement is based upon the completion of an A.S. degree in Marine Science at Gloucester County College.

A. Criteria for admission to the College and/or the specific upper-level program:

Students graduating from the associate degree program at Gloucester

Prospective students must submit a standard application to Richard Stockton College and pay the required fees.

County College shall not be held liable for any action taken by the State of New Jersey, directly or indirectly, in a manner contrary to the laws of the State of New Jersey. All that said laws have not been violated and shall not be violated as they relate to
