Re: Intent to Terminate Certificate Program for Student Assistance Coordinator

In accordance with University Procedure 2040: The Life Cycle of Degree Programs, this memorandum conveys the unanimous faculty votes of the Psychology and Education programs to terminate the Student Assistance Coordinator certificate program. At their respective program meetings on September 1, 2015, faculty from both programs voted to accept separate applications for this program. Deans from both schools have met with the adjunct faculty members who have been teaching in this program to develop a "teach out" plan.

Two of the three enrolled students will complete their program by June 2016. The third enrolled student will receive assistance in transferring to another institution.

In order to inform the higher education community, increase our understanding of trends in academic offerings, and enhance advisement to prospective students, the University will continue to have an intent to terminate a program to its internal and external constituencies.
