Another 11% dent f ed nflat on or cost of l v n as the man sercent dent f ed abort on, and all other ssues olled n the lows n led half (57%) were very enthus ast c about vot n n the m dterms, and 21% we enthus ast c. But more Re ubl cans sad they were ea er to vote; 7 % were com ared to 54% of Democrats and 55% of nde endents.

Voters n blue-state New Jersey were evenly s lt nthe r feel n s about Pre w th 4 % hav n favorable v ews and 47% hav n unfavorable v ews. A major nclud n 24% of Democrats – d d not want B den to run for re-elect on n 2 7% of voters – nclud n 2 % of Re ubl cans – d d not want former Pres de to run a a n n two years.
