



Sen. Joseph Krillos, by a similar, sizable 56 percent to 33 percent margin, according to the poll.

The poll found that 2nd District voters are split on what they think about Gov. Chris Christie.

Forty-seven percent thought he was doing either a decent or good job, while 51 percent rated it as fair or poor.

But on the other hand, 51 percent had an either somewhat favorable opinion of the governor, versus 46 percent who view him unfavorably.

The poll of 624 voters, conducted between Sept. 19 and 24, had a 4 percent margin of error, meaning Christie's ratings are essentially tied.
