Stockton: Booker leads Lonegan by 11 points

New Jersey's race for U.S. Senate has tightened to within 11 percentage points, with Democrat Cory Booker leading statewide poll released today by the Stockton Polling Institute.

When respondents who say they are voting for or leaning toward voting for either candidate are included, Booker, the while former Bogota Mayor Lonegan received 39 percent. With one week until the Oct. 16 special election, the 11-po respondents who are undecided or refuse to identify who they will vote for. Lonegan is in the position to have to converge Booker.

"Still, 11 points is a healthy lead for Booker with the election coming up next Wednesday," said Daniel J. Douglas, Di Policy.
