Among the things he says he knows are leadership skills, punctuality and the importance of delivering on promises. He's championing a five-point plan to flatten income, sales, and corporate taxes; consolidating government agencies; and cut legislative paychecks by 20 percent.

None of the major-party candidates responded to repeated calls for comment.
