Galloway, NJ -The New Jersey state Legislature does not look a lot like the statewide constituency it represents, according to research published today by the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy at Stockton University.

The New Jersey Legislature is older, is much better educated and is more white collar than the overall New Jersey population, according to the report, [New Jersey State Legislature: A Demographic Profile](#), by Stockton University researcher John Froomjian and graduate assistant Daniel Rockefeller.

The researchers compiled a database of demographic characteristics of all 120 members of the state Senate and General Assembly, and compared those characteristics with the general population.
