



Stockton Polling Institute: LoBiondo Leads Shober in 2nd Congressional District; Obama Over Romney; Menendez Leads Kyrillos

Galloway, NJ – The Stockton Polling Institute today released a poll of the 2nd congressional district showing Republican incumbent Frank LoBiondo leading Democratic challenger Cassandra Shober by a margin of 55 percent to 35 percent.

The Stockton Polling Institute is part of the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy at the Richard Stockton College of New Jersey. The poll was conducted with 624 likely voters from September 19 – 24. Interviewers called both land lines and cell phones. The survey has a margin of error of +/-4.0 percent.

New Jersey's 2nd congressional district includes all of Atlantic, Cape May, Cumberland, Salem and parts of Burlington, Camden and Gloucester counties.

"Congressman LoBiondo's lead is expected given his 18 years in Congress," said Daniel J. Douglas, Director of the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy.

Of all those surveyed, 62 percent have a very or somewhat favorable opinion of the LoBiondo, while 19 percent have a somewhat or very unfavorable opinion, with 18 percent unsure or unfamiliar with him.

For Shober, 56 percent of those surveyed are unfamiliar or not sure of what they think of her.
