**Galloway Township, NJ** - The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey is hosting one of this year's Varsity Vocals' International Competition of Collegiate a Cappella (ICCA) Mid-Atlantic quarterfinals. The event will be held in the Performing Arts Center on **Saturday, Feb. 14**.

For a growing national a cappella community, the ICCA is the most significant yearly event.

There are five Mid-Atlantic quarterfinals, with two winners from each going to the Mid-Atlantic semifinals, leading up to the winner of each region competing in the finals in New York City.
