Russ Manson, Associate Professor, Computational Science – “The Development and Application of a Mathematical Modeling System for Simulating Water Circulation, and Heat and Salinity Transport in Rivers, Estuaries and Fjords” – Presentation of a computational model for natural earth systems and its application to modeling in lakes.

Jill Gerhardt, Associate Professor, Computer Science and Information Systems, Michael Cronin, Assistant Professor, Social Work and MaryAnn Trail, Public Services Librarian/Associate Professor in the Library – “Just do it Online” – Presentation of improved student performance when classroom and library materials are made accessible online.
