Galloway Township, NJ - Dr. Theresa Bartolotta was named as the new dean of the School of Health Sciences and Dr. Lisa Honaker was confirmed as dean of the School of Arts and Humanities (ARHU) and Gregory J. Coffin was appointed as the new police chief of the Campus Police by the Board of Trustees of The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey at their May 7, 2014 meeting.

All three appointments came after extensive searches to fill the positions.
