The producers for the production are Paul and Pattye Herron, founders of Atlantic City Theater and Fool Moon Theatre. The show is directed by Richard McMahan, with Rose Selah and Victoria Biron as stage managers. The cast includes Megan Elizabeth, Mark Glickstein, Greg LeCuyer, Lorraine McCarty, Ken Groome, Kate Read, Kristaps Lintins and Jay Frederickson.

This is the sixth in a series of collaborative productions between Dante Hall and Atlantic City Theater aimed at bringing great theater to Atlantic City. Now in its second year, Atlantic City Theater includes members who have decades of experience and have performed, directed, designed and produced shows with organizations such as Stockton University, South Jersey Regional Theater, the Gateway Playhouse, Fool Moon Theatre, the Ocean City Pops, Margate Little Theatre, and Showmakers.

Located in the heart of the historic Duck Town neighborhood of Atlantic City, Dante Hall was originally built in 1926 by St. Michael's Catholic Church. Dante Hall served the community of the neighborhood as a church hall, school gymnasium and community theater until it closed in 1988. In October 2003, Dante Hall reopened after a complete renovation, funded solely by the Casino Reinvestment Development Authority (CRDA). In 2011, Stockton University acquired the venue, allowing it to continue to serve Atlantic City and surrounding communities as a home for the performing arts. By providing quality programming and performances to local communities, Stockton University and Dante Hall Theater aim to strengthen New Jersey's efforts in restoring Atlantic City as a cultural and family destination.
