Collection boxes can be found at Kramer Hall, located at 30 Front St. in Hammonton, N.J. and on the main Galloway campus in front of the Mail Services Department in Lower F-wing.

Items being collected include: clean summer clothing for all ages, towels, washcloths, sheets, pillowcases, pillows, baseball caps, straw hats, art supplies, cards, dominoes, small toys (no stuffed animals), reading glasses, folding chairs, yoga and beach mats, stadium cushions, canvas luggage, backpacks, tote bags, fly swatters and flashlights with batteries.
