Galloway, NJ Murphy Writing of Stockton University will host the Shore Thing Writing Getaway on **Saturday, June 4** from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The writing retreat will be held at Dante Hall Theater, located at 14 N. Mississippi Ave. in Atlantic City, N.J. The program is currently accepting registrations from community members and Stockton students interested in writing poetry, fiction or nonfiction.

Following the method that workshop leader Peter Murphy, an adjunct instructor at Stockton, has developed in his 35 years of teaching, participants will discuss the craft of creative writing before working on prompts challenging writing for expression and discovery. Participants will then share their work in read-around sessions.

The unique prompts will allow both beginning and experienced writers to benefit from the program. The workshop creates a welcoming, encouraging environment for a community of writers.

Writing is typically a solitary act, Murphy explained. But when writers come together in a supportive community that encourages them to push their boundaries, they often experience breakthroughs.
