Murphy Writing of Stockton University will hold a Writing and Publishing Retreat, Read and Write, from Aug. 16-21 at Dexter's Inn in Sunapee, NH.

Open to community members and Stockton students who are interested in memoir, creative nonfiction or personal essays. Writers will be attending from all over the Northeast, especially New Jersey, and this is a final call for registrations.

Attending the Writing and Publishing Retreat will gain confidence and coaching on how to write and publish their writing, said Peter Murphy, founder of Murphy Writing and Publishing at Stockton. Throughout the week, participants will put a work-in-progress manuscript through rounds of revision, get feedback on their work and learn how to effectively navigate the publishing world. By the end of the retreat, they will submit a piece of writing for publication.

The retreat will be led by Amanda Morris, a professor of writing at Kutztown University of Pennsylvania who worked as a freelance writer for 11 years.

"I was very impressed," said Susan Hutchinson of Newtown, PA, a participant in one of Morris' previous workshops. "Amanda was full of energy, interesting, and very inspiring. I would come back just for her, but I very much enjoyed the whole experience."

"Many writers want to publish their work, but too many stop short of the final goal," Murphy said. "This workshop will provide valuable support and resources to help writers publish."
