Galloway Township, NJ - The 13th Annual Day of Scholarship is a showcase of distinctive research projects and collaborations between students, faculty and staff from all fields of study at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey.

Day of Scholarship will take place Thursday, March 21, 2013 from 8:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the Campus Center, located on the College's main Galloway campus. Dr. Harvey Kesselman, provost and executive vice president, will welcome guests with opening remarks and Stockton President Herman J. Saatkamp will speak in the afternoon at 12 p.m. The event is free and open to the public.

Throughout the day, more than 70 presentations will be delivered by faculty, staff and students from all eight of the College's academic schools. Bringing together a diverse pool of talent, the event gives an overview of the projects that took place during the past year including grant-funded projects, internally-funded projects, research endeavors, professional development, sabbaticals, study tours and academic achievements.

There are 20-minute presentations as well as longer 40-minute and 50-minute panel discussions that give multiple perspectives on various topics. Posters will be on display all day.

The topics include the globalization of healthcare, art discoveries at the Vineland Historical and Antiquarian Society, Tai Chi for breast cancer survivors, a recap of the 2012 study tour to Holocaust sites in Poland and Germany, community engagement and mathematical modeling.
