Construction Corner: Pomona Road Parking Lot Project to Commence

The project will create 493 parking spaces.

The parking lot will feature ADA (Americans with Disabilities) parking, a bus shelter, a turnaround loop for buses, lights, security cameras and blue phones for emergencies. The project will also include the development of a road connecting the Athletics Complex to Louisville Avenue (south of Lot 7) via the existing Delaware Avenue, along with sidewalks and street lights. Future phases of the project could add 343 additional parking spaces.
