and also is approximately 2,250 square feet with 163 feet of wall space.

"This space represents possibilities," said Rodger Jackson, associate professor of philosophy and vice president of the faculty senate. "We had a swimming pool that was no longer functional. We could have gone with the status quo, or we could have used imagination. The College went with imaginative thinking and look at what we have here today."
