“Stockton is determined that future generations will learn about the Holocaust and other genocides to ensure that they never happen again,” Kesselman said.

Survivors Ruth Fisch Kessler; Hanna Granek Ehrlich; and _____, Stockton professor emeritus of Holocaust Studies; and extended family of all those portrayed were present. Each survivor family received a large framed photo of their family member’s portrait at a private reception.

Bockelmann drew the survivors’ siblings from photographs, to give faces to some of the 1.5 million children murdered during the Holocaust. His niece, Marion Hussong, professor of Literature and the Carol Rittner Professor of Holocaust and _____ the project to fruition, along with faculty, staff and students from the Sara & Sam Schoffer Holocaust Resource Center and the Art Gallery.

Hundreds of Stockton students also have visited the exhibit, as part of a class or as individuals, and some were trained as docents, or guides. “Docents are Stockton students from all different majors,” said Gail Rosenthal, director of the Sara _____ learning about a history that they didn’t realize paralleled some of today’s issues.”
