Stockton Summer Enrollment Increases

More students enrolled in courses at Stockton University this summer to accelerate their degree programs or lighten their course loads for the fall and spring terms.

Stockton's overall summer enrollment grew to reach the full-time equivalent (FTE) of 1,991, up 6.9 percent from 1,863 in Summer 2014. In 2013, the FTE was 1,808.

"We remained fairly steady among undergraduates, having witnessed strong growth last year, and we saw very strong growth among graduates," said Rob Gregg, dean of the School of General Studies.
